**GRANTED BY THE MADEIRA SCHOOLS FOUNDATION**

The Madeira Schools Foundation (MSF) will award up to five (5) scholarships totaling \$6,000 this year to graduating seniors of Madeira High School. Scholarships must be used for higher education in accredited non-proprietary universities, colleges, or vocational schools. A MSF scholarship recipient is free to accept other scholarships.

The following information and supporting documentation must accompany the application in order for the application to be considered complete. ***Less than full documentation will disqualify the applicant and application will be eliminated.***

1. An official transcript of high school credits, including rank in class, grade-point average, and SAT/ACT scores.
2. Completed form indicating reason for attending college or vocational school, determination to succeed, leadership.
3. Supporting financial forms indicating need. This includes a copy of the Free Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and a completed U.S. Tax Return (IRS Form 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ) for student and parents.
4. Two letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes or mailed directly to address below. (Only one from a teacher of applicant's choice and one from other source not related to applicant).
5. All of the above information and supporting documents should be submitted in **triplicate** (one copy per judge). If not, copies will be made for the judges only.
6. ALL INFORMATION WILL BE HELD IN STRICTEST CONFIDENCE BY THE JUDGING COMMITTEE. AFTER JUDGING, ALL APPLICATIONS, EXCEPT WINNERS, WILL BE SHREDDED. **ALL IRS FORMS WILL BE SHREDDED.**
7. The Judging Committee will consist of three persons. No member of the Judging Committee shall be a Madeira School's Foundation Trustee or a member of the MSF Scholarship Committee.

The Judging Committee will review applications for compliance with our standards. Awards will be granted on the following basis: 50% based on need; 50% based on character, determination to succeed, academic achievement or improvement, and leadership ability.

Scholarship payment will be sent directly to the college, university, or vocational school of the recipient's choice.

**It will be the obligation of the recipient of a scholarship award to report his/her progress to the MSF Scholarship Committee Chairman at the end of each semester or quarter.**
