District nurses conduct yearly vision and hearing screenings in all buildings according to Ohio Department of Health guidelines. Students in preschool, kindergarten, first, third, fifth, seventh, and ninth grades are screened, as well as all students who are new to the district.

Scoliosis screening is conducted at Madeira Middle School for fifth and seventh grade girls, and eighth grade boys.

If a student does not pass the school screening, a letter is sent home to the parent or guardian recommending a follow up appointment with a health care provider or specialist.
