#### **Getting Started - Day One Homework**

- Get familiar with the student handbook!
  - Who does what?
  - What is expected and available?
  - Where to go for help?
  - When things are happening?

#### **Starting Safety Protocols**

- Home wellness checks prior to sending to school.
- Masks strongly recommended.
- All students on school buses are <u>required</u> to wear masks.
  - Incidence of being identified as a close contact can be reduced by getting vaccinated or wearing a mask.
- Cleaning protocols for surfaces and classroom sanitizing stations.
- Outdoor classroom spaces will continue to be used.
- Ventilation settings will continue to circulate outside air.
- Refillable water bottles recommended.
- Social distancing in classrooms with assigned seating.
- Use of lockers and backpacks.
- Expanded lunchroom seating options.

### **Testing and PE**

**PE Waiver** - If a student *completes 2 Seasons* of the following activities, his/her PE requirement will be "waived":

- Marching Band and Color Guard
- Cheerleading
- Any interscholastic sport in grades 9-11

It is "all or nothing" - no partial waiver, and the waiver does not equal "credit".

**State Testing** - Students will take the following end-of-course assessments in April of the freshman year:

Algebra or Geometry (2 tests 90 minutes each)

#### **Technology**

- Chromebooks assigned to every student grades 9-12
  - Purchased by the district
  - Maintained and repaired by the district
  - Collected at the end of the school year
- Complete Online Registration to:
  - Agree to the Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)
  - Select participation in Computer Insurance Program
    - Insurance payment is collected separately

#### Insurance Plan - "Highlights"

#### The Insurance Plan is here to help you!

- Voluntary if you opt in, you must pay by August 31st
- Total premium cost is \$25.00
  - Covers any accidental break and fix of the device
  - Does NOT cover intentional damage
  - Does NOT cover LOST or STOLEN Chromebooks or power cords
  - Replacements include different models and rebuilds
- The premium is non-refundable
- Lost/stolen Chromebooks cost \$225.00 to replace
- Power cords cost \$25.00 to replace
