A group of Madeira residents gathered at Madeira High School (MHS) April 18 for bagels, coffee, and a conversation about what's going on in their school district.

Madeira Superintendent's Community Coffees are held each fall and spring to give people a chance to reconnect with the district. At the recent spring coffee, Superintendent Kenji Matsudo talked to the group about three MHS students who received perfect scores on the ACT this year, staff retirees and their successors, and the MHS track being closed the month of June for a track replacement.
