- Monitoring my health daily. I will connect with a medical professional if I experience any of the COVID-19 symptoms: fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher, cough, difficulty breathing or shortness of breath, chills, unusual muscle aches, sore throat or new loss of taste or smell.
- Staying home if I have COVID-19-related symptoms, even if I feel well enough to come to school.
- Following all required local health guidance related to isolating and self-quarantining for the prescribed period of time after exposure to someone who is ill or has tested positive for COVID-19.
- Remaining positive, supportive, empathic and non-judgmental to other Madeira family members who may test positive for COVID-19.
- Washing my hands frequently using soap and water (or, if not available, hand sanitizer). Contribute to the cleaning of classroom spaces and other surfaces, as requested.
- Being positive and gracious when others provide safety reminders and suggestions.
- Being attentive and helpful to anyone who may be in need of support.
