

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN MADEIRA RECEIVES CONFIRMATION THAT A STUDENT OR STAFF MEMBER IS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19?

FIRST HAND REPORT OF POSITIVE CASE OF COVID-19



Show care and concern for any student/staff member who may become ill.

In most instances, we will receive a phone call from home where the student/staff is indicating a positive test result.

If student is at school, student reports to nurse's office and is sent home.

If employee is at work, immediately goes home.

Affected areas immediately receive disinfecting protocol.

Students & Staff should stay home if they have been exposed and are waiting for test results.

MADEIRA CONTACTS HAMILTON COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT



Madeira team works with health department to investigate and identify all possible close contact positive exposure.

Positive Close Contact exposure is:

- 15 minutes or more of consecutive exposure
- Close contact within 6 feet (mask or no mask)

MADEIRA INFORMS CLOSE CONTACTS



Any family or staff member with confirmed close contact exposure receives a phone call and email from Madeira within 24 hours.

Anyone with close contact exposure will receive a close contact notification letter and be placed by Hamilton County Public Health in a 14 day quarantine.

MADEIRA INFORMS BUILDING AND DISTRICT



Students and staff who attend class with a Madeira student or staff member who has a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 are notified by email.

Remember, the best way to prevent COVID-19 is to practice good hand hygiene, wear a face mask, and continue social distancing.

MADEIRA MONITORS DATA



Madeira administrators work with public health officials to continually monitor numbers of staff and students who are quarantining and have confirmed cases.

Individuals' privacy is ALWAYS protected.
