Secret ballots would be a violation of the Sunshine Law. Ohio law requires a majority vote of all members of the board to elect an officer. Once the officers have been elected and sworn in, the meeting will proceed with the newly elected president presiding.*

Nothing in this resolution shall require the Board of Education to employ or continue to employ an individual who has not provided a criminal records check satisfactory to the Board or who has not satisfied any other prerequisite to employment created by law or Board Policy.
