**Extra and Co-Curricular** supplemental compensation falls into multiple categories. The supplemental may be a direct result of the identification by the Superintendent or direct reports as critical to the operation of the district. (**Rubric 3-Essential, Rubric 2-Important, but not critical, Rubric 1-Selective, but not critical.**)

**New club/activity** – Building Administration are responsible for submitting a recommendation of approval for any new club/activity using the Budget Purpose Statement process. With Building Administrative approval the sponsor of the club/activity may apply for a stipend after three years of successful growth and demonstrating sustainability.

Rubric 3 – Activity/Club in this category involves a large time commitment, up to a year long program and supervising 5-10 students. Organizational responsibilities include such factors as coordination with students, staff, parents, and external organizations, budgeting, and producing a product or event critical to the needs of the organization. (Stipend is approximately 8% to 9% of BA-0, based on experience in the position).

Rubric 2 – Activity/Clubs in this category involve six or more contact hours a week outside the school day, supervision of small groups of students and/or large grade levels of students at certain times during the year and practice/rehearsals. Organizational responsibilities include such factors as coordination with students, staff, parents, and external organizations, budgeting, and coordinating one or more events during the season/year. (Stipend is approximately 3% to 5% of BA-0, based on experience in the position)

(Stipend is approximately 2.5% to 3.5% of BA-0, based on experience within the position)

(Stipend is approximately <b>1% to 2%</b> of BA-0, based on experience within the position)
